

Use of the Pontoon at Resort Content

1. To reserve the pontoon, you must sign up in the office and pay in advance.
2. We rent by the ½ day (4 hours) and the full day (8 hours).
3. The cost is \$50 (\$53.44) for a half day and \$100 (\$106.88) for a full day.
4. We furnish only the first tank of gas. The pontoon holds 2 tanks. Expect to pay for additional gas used. Do not attempt to gas the pontoon yourself.
5. We have discontinued the practice of allowing one party to reserve the pontoon for an entire week to give more of our guests the opportunity to use the pontoon.
6. You may sign up as often as you wish. The weekly charge for repeated use shall not exceed \$350 (plus tax) for the week. Gas is extra!
7. When you sign up you must indicate the departure time for your group. Please be prompt!
8. Keys will be issued at departure time and must be turned in when you return. Do not leave them on the pontoon or put them in your pocket.
9. Time between groups is needed to gas the pontoon. There will be an additional charge if you are late in returning the pontoon.
10. In some situations, such as bad weather, it may be possible to reschedule or delay your departure. Please contact us.
11. The maximum occupancy we allow is equivalent to 8 adults.
12. Life jackets must be worn by all individuals. It is not acceptable to have the life jacket on the seat beside you. Let us know if you do not have your own life jackets.
13. You must indicate a designated driver or responsible party who is expected to operate the pontoon in a safe and law abiding manner.
14. The consumption of alcoholic beverages is forbidden. This applies to not only the driver but all passengers as well.
15. It is not acceptable to anchor and use the pontoon as a diving/swimming platform.
16. We ask that the driver and all passengers board the pontoon at our location. We prefer that you do not dock or go to shore at other points on the lake.
17. No pets allowed!
18. Please remove all equipment and clean up after your group.

19. Yes, we do rent to groups who are not staying at our resort. However, resort guests are our first priority. Note, we may not know weeks in advance whether or not the pontoon is available during the week.
20. Your best opportunity to rent the pontoon as an outside group is either Saturday or Sunday. Our change over on the resort occurs on Saturday. One group of guests leaves on Saturday morning and another group checks in late in the day.
21. However, we are extremely busy on Saturday. All final arrangements to rent the pontoon must be made in person by Friday evening. All we have time to do on Saturday is hand you the key.
22. A charge of \$10 per person is added to the rental fee for individuals who are not registered resort guests.
23. You may be asked to pay for any loss or damage that may occur such as a lost anchor or torn seats. It is a good idea to look the pontoon over before departure.
